Career History

Susan Davies commenced taking on private patients and contracts alongside employment in 1985.

Examples of typical patient caseload diagnoses are: Multiple Sclerosis, Parkinson's disease, Chronic

Fatigue Syndrome, Head Injury, Stroke, Spinal Injuries, Vertigo and neuropathies.

In 2005 Susan King-Davies's private practice was expanded, eventually being incorporated into a limited

company, E-Physio Associates Limited in 2006. The practice patient base and geographical coverage has

increased substantially. Currently, the practice has a patient base of approximately

800, which includes a

number of serious brain injury patients. The practice operates a domiciliary service covering Kent, Essex,

Surrey and East London.

Patient referrals are predominantly from consultants, solicitors, GP's, colleagues, insurance companies and

self referrals through word-of-mouth.

E-Physio Associates Limited has two clinics based in Billericay, Essex and Sanderstead, Surrey. From

these two bases both neurological and musculoskeletal cases are treated, as clinic and /or domiciliary

appointments. The practice employs in house and self-employed physiotherapists. The practice has

undertaken undergraduate Physio Assistant sponsorship at Colchester University, taken on Shell Step

undergraduate placements and student work experience candidates.
